

SORT AS YOU GO! Once you fill a container, sort and bag your caps so you can weigh them. We kept bags at about 20 lbs. each. Keep in mind caps weigh different amounts.


ASK PHARMACIES TO SAVE THEIR STOCK CAPS! These are heavier than normal caps. We picked up once a week.
